## WHO WE ARE

Sociolab ([www.sociolab.it](http://www.sociolab.it)) is a multidisciplinary research centre composed of a group of experts in the fields of participatory development and participatory processes, consensus building, conflict mediation, social and political research, network analysis, training and communication. Sociolab works with and for a variety of actors in the public and in the private sector, as well as with civil society groups and International organizations.

The centre specifically designs and implements projects targeting the engagement and direct involvement of local communities and stakeholders in project design, implementation and strategic decision making; the promotion of social innovation; the effectiveness and inclusiveness of public and private communication; the production of in depth field research to help policy makers and the private sector to better respond to the needs of communities.

Sociolab works on a variety of issues and areas in the social and political domains, ranging from management of the commons, social innovation in public policies, the transformation of the urban and social environment, health, education and gender equality.

Sociolab applies social research methods and facilitation tools and techniques to design projects that actively involve communities and stakeholders in key public decisions and strategic planning; develop toolkits and materials aimed at communication and training; support organizations and individuals in assessing and prioritizing needs; conduct socio-political assessments and network analysis.

Since 2006 Sociolab has developed more than 200 projects and has reached more than 13.500 stakeholders and participants with interviews, workshops and seminars.

Over the years Sociolab has provided methodological support to the Regional Governments of Tuscany, Emilia Romagna and Liguria and for the Municipality of Florence, Livorno and Prato (among many others), on a variety of issues ranging from participatory emergency response, risk reduction and climate mitigation policies, to organisation development, public policy effectiveness and the challenges of the sharing economy.
